Learning Management Systems are software applications that organize and structure online learning (both asynchronously and synchronously).

Video (Zoom, Google Classroom, Microsoft Teams, etc.)

Interactive Tools

Collaborative documents such as Google Docs

<u>Kialo</u>: public discussion and debates (also try <u>Kialo for educators</u>)

Mentimeter: real-time polls, quizzes, word clouds, and Q&A's for interactive presentations and meetings

<u>Padlet</u>: online notice board with functions for collaboration, uploading documents, and creating content

Whiteboard.fi: an online whiteboard tool for classroom use

Canva: create posters, infographics, presentations, social media posts, and more



Blogger: a free site to create and publish blogs

<u>Camtasia</u>: screen recorder and video editor
